Appeal
UFCW Local 416P - Locked Out

Approximately 61 members of UFCW Local 416P have been locked out since April 25, 2007, by their employer Horizon Milling, a grain milling operation whose parent company is Cargill Ltd. The Union had been negotiating after their contract expired on November 30, 2006 without any progress.

During this period the company has been removing all the grain stored in the elevator. When that is completed, the company will shut down the entire operation. The finished product produced by the members was shipped out before they were locked out.

The employer is not prepared to negotiate a fair and equitable resolve for the membership.
